RESOLUTION APPROVING SCHEDULE OF RATES
EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2020

WHEREAS, the Penns Grove Sewerage Authority has been mandated by the State of New Jersey to provide for the secondary treatment of all sewer effluent processed by the facility, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the revenues of the Authority are at all times adequate to pay the expenses of operation and maintenance of the system, including reserves, insurance, extensions, and replacements, and to pay the principal of and interest on bonds and to maintain such reserves of sinking funds as may be required or as may be deemed necessary or desirable by the Authority, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to revise the schedule of service charges and rates which became effective June 1, 2009, to adequately pay the expenses of operation and maintenance of the sewer system, including reserves, insurances, extensions, and replacements, and to pay the principal of and interest on any bonds and loans to maintain such reserves or sinking funds as may be deemed necessary or desirable by the authority, and


WHEREAS, a public hearing was held in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:14B-23 at the Penns Grove Sewerage Authority Administrative Office, 81 Beach Avenue, Penns Grove, New Jersey on June 18, 2020, at 5:00 P.M. , at which time the members of the public had the opportunity to make statements and/or posed questions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Penns Grove Sewerage Authority, that its schedule of rates effective June 1, 2009 be revised as follows;
