Mr. Morris made a motion to accept the minutes for the March 19, 2020 and April 20, 2020 meeting and was approved by Mr. Poindexter and was seconded by Mr. Washington.

Mr. Morris made a motion to approve the Resolution 2020-5-1 for two Foreclosures and one land only taken off the books and was approved by Mr. Washington and second by Mr. Poindexter.

Mr. Morris made a motion to adopt the Budget and was approved by Mr. Poindexter and second by Mr. Washington.

Mr. Morris discussed rate increase. Notice of Public Hearing will be published in the newspaper and will be held on June 18, 2020 at the Penns Grove Sewerage Authority Office. If adopted, the proposed sewer service rate increase will be implemented over the next two (2) years on June 1 of 2020 and 2021.

Mr. Boden stated that he is waiting on bid specs for roof from Sickels.

Mr. Boden stated that KRS installed mud-valve in Chlorine Contact tank. Also, Sluice Gates are being refurbished by Maurer Construction.

Mr. Borden stated that one side of the Primary tank is not working due to broken chain drive. Having that repaired by KRS, that was included in the projects, but now can not wait. Obtaining prices for all the projects.

Mr. Borden stated that he is working on NJDEP Permit renewal.

Mr. Morris made a motion to pay the bills and was approved by Mr. Washington and was seconded by Mr. Poindexter.
