

Penns Grove Sewerage Authority

November 18, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Penns Grove Sewerage Authority was called to order by our Chairperson, Mrs. James, at 5:00 P.M. on November 18, 2021 in accordance with Public Law 1075, Chapter 231. Notice of this meeting was advertised in the South Jersey Times and on the website.

Present at the meeting were:

Mrs. Mary Kay James, Mr. Carl Washington and Mr. Abasi Moyenda.

Mrs. James said the Solar Project was okayed waiting to hear from the borough

The letter of Intent for pre-application meeting for connection to PGSA was voted on and was approved first by Mr. Washington and seconded by Mr. Moyenda all voted in favor.

Mr. Boden stated that Penn Valley Pump was ordered on 10/22/21. Lead time is 6-8 weeks. Once the pump is delivered installation will be scheduled.

Mr. Boden stated that the Salem County Board of Health and Human services conducted the annual inspection of the underground storage tanks and the generators on 11/4/21 and all went well.

Mr. Boden stated that the State of New Jersey Department of Community Affairs conducted a fire inspection of our site on 11/15/21. They have advised us of a few issues. We need to install Carbon-Monoxide detectors in the office and the pole barn. We will also need to install lighted exit signs and is waiting on full report before proceeding.

Mr. Boden stated that the meeting with Carneys Point Sewerage Authority on 10/21/21 was to discuss possible acceptance of approximately 100k of Carneys Points flow from their Delaware Ave. pump station. They would like us to allow them to pursue this further with NJDEP, to see if it is feasible.

Mr. Boden stated that the cost of repair or replacement of the Cat Generator Injecting System rebuild and Control upgrade with rental generator will be \$41,885.00 under Capital Improvements. A motion to approve was made by Mr. James approved by Mr. Moyenda and second by Mr. Washington All Voted yes to the motion.

Mr. William DePhillipo of Keystone Power Holdings, LLC, talked about trying to buy properties to aggregate use of power lines in order to get the money back to the Sewerage Authority.

Mrs. James made a motion to pay the bills and was approved by Mr. Washington and was seconded by Mr. Moyenda.

Mrs. James made a motion to adjourn meeting and was approved by Mr. Washington and seconded by Mr. Moyenda.
